Dear Ms. Nelms:

Your recent behavior of making unjustified demands of me and your constant harassment of referring your bill collectors to me, must and will stop immediately.

If it does not stop I will cut off your monthly distribution immediately and it will not begin again until and at which time I think it is appropriate.

If you question my authority to do so, perhaps you should read the trust under Distributions. page 7, B.8.a. - especially (2) and (4).

In addition, I am herewith requiring you to get help for your mental instability immediately. I want to see proof of your attendance within no longer than one month. I am aware of a state sponsored program for such help with no cost to the recipient. If I do not see the above required proof you can expect that you will not receive a distribution check for November of this year and thereafter until I am satisfied that you get the mental help you so badly need.

It is much easier for me at this time to see and understand why our mother did not, under any circumstances, want you to share in any of her estate. As you well know, it was only at my insistence that she finally relented and agreed to put you in the will, but very reluctantly and under my control.

I hope for your own good that you heed my requirements.
